Receive up to 12 weeks of child care assistance for children birth through 12-years old



Children in Fulton County may receive short-term child care assistance if their household has been adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Eligible Fulton County Cities:

- Chattahoochee Hills
- College Park
- East Point
- Fairburn
- Hapeville
- Johns Creek

- Mountain Park
- Palmetto
- Roswell

- Union City
- South Fulton



Eligible families must meet the following:

- Have a total household income less than 200% of the state median income
- Have experienced job loss or reduction in income related to COVID-19
- Not receiving the state CAPS child care subsidy

Required documentation to upload in application:

- Current state or federal photo identification
- Proof of residency in an eligible Fulton County city

Other details:

- Families can attend any licensed program or program legally exempt from licensing by the GA Department of Early Care and Learning. Program must be an "in-person" program.
- QCC will only pay for published child care rates not exceeding more than \$180 per week per child.
