OVERVIEW

Each Medallion who completes a Medallion Project, whether individually or as part of a group, will write an essay evaluating their project. The essay should focus on your thoughts about the project's plan, its implementation, and its results. This is your personal reflection on the project.

STRUCTURE

- 1.5 to 2 pages in essay format
- Double spaced
- Font size 12

QUESTIONS TO REFLECT UPON WHILE WRITING THE PAPER

- Why did you choose this project?
- How has completing this project changed your perspective?
- If working in a group, how did the group dynamics hinder or simplify your project?
- If working on your own, did that make completing your project easier or harder?
- How did your project impact the community?
- How did the project impact you personally?
- Is this a project you would do again?
- If you could add more to your project, what would you add?
- What went well?
- What did not go so well and what could you have done or what did you do to make it better?
